Some verses were already scratche d by then: "With an Indian flutist who marked the time signature/ All all f riends..." They built a house somewhere close to the sea and went to Bahia, Ouro Preto and Rio de Janeiro. Eduardo got a job at Banco Central and Môni ca is a professor.[3]</p>
