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There are two basic colloquial words. Sandwich is fine, as per Ian T's answer, but if you're in the South of England a frequent version is sarnie (Bacon Sarnies, Fried Egg Sarnies, for example). If you're in North, it's often Butty or Buttie; (Chi) Tj T* BT /F
